I recently attended an event entitled, 'My place,' organised by PCI, to help congregations like ours, explore ways of including children with special additional needs in worship and children's ministry!

I found the evening very helpful and deeply challenging in so many ways, but two things that especially struck me where these. First the simple statement, 'when you've met one autistic person, you've met (only) ONE autistic person.' The temptation to generalise and so forget to treat each individual as the unique creation they are, is

very real and very damaging, not only to the individual and his or her family, but to us all. As I was reminded of this, I found myself quietly praying that God would help all of us in Woodlands to do so much better with this.

The second statement was this, 'God doesn't stop revealing Himself at a certain IQ.' A fabulous reminder, even rebuke, for those of us who sometimes wonder how people with 'special needs' can truly grasp the Gospel and be saved. They can and they do, as easily (or perhaps we should say, with the same degree of difficulty) as the rest of us. With man salvation is always impossible, but not with God, with God all things are always, whatever our abilities or disabilities, POSSIBLE.

I am especially thankful to God for the children and adults with special needs that God has entrusted us within Woodlands. As we look to the future may God give us grace and wisdom to ensure that as far as possible, whatever a person's abilities or needs, they can truly call this place, MY place, MY people, MY home. God bless.

#### **Session Report 2017**

2017 carried great significance for the Reformed Faith as it was the 500th Anniversary of the Reformation. Whilst many had been used by God to lay the foundations for the Reformation eg Wycliffe, Huss and Tyndale, it was the action of Luther nailing his 95 Theses to the door of Wittenberg Castle on the 31st October 1517 that instigated the recovery of truth. He had no idea what he was letting himself in for. As with the reformers, this is what we stand for at Woodlands:

Sola Scriptura – the bible is our only authority for belief and practice 2 Timothy 3v16, 17

Sola Fide – we are saved by faith alone in Christ Ephesians 2v8, 9
Sola Gratia – salvation is the gift of God by grace Ephesians 2v8, 9
Sola Christos – Christ's work alone saves 1 Peter 2v24

Soli Deo gloria – we live to the glory of God alone 1 Corinthians 10v31

After another year of ministry at Woodlands we have tried to live out these truths to all whom we have encountered. We thank God for the many leaders and helpers different ministries who have demonstrated the above truths in how they have lived and interacted with those to whom they ministered. As a leadership we are grateful and appreciative of their faithful service and commitment. Their love for those outside the kingdom is clearly evident as is their passion to see people grow in grace. Many

Woodlanders have displayed the Reformation convictions outlined above to both young and old, whether in the kingdom or still in desperate need of salvation.

We give particular thanks for the praise during the worship services which constantly prepares us to encounter the Word. Once more we give thanks to God for Leslie and the gifts and the passion which God has given him for the preaching and application of the Word.

God's goodness to us begs a number of questions as we put another year behind us. God has abundantly blessed this fellowship and yet our response to His goodness seems decidedly mixed. I would ask the believers Woodlands what are you presently studying in God's word as you seek to grow in grace. What are you actively learning and applying in your life? What is your prayer life like? How are you responding to the goodness God has shown you? What do you stand for? Have you any idea of what you letting yourself in for if God gets a hold of your life?

This is just a snapshot of the work of committee and I would like to thank those members who give of their time and talent so that Church can function in an often unnoticed way.

#### Treasurer's Report 2017

Our God is a very, very faithful God.

As I review the accounts of our congregation, not only for this year, but over the past number of years I am struck by how year after year He has, through the generosity, faithfulness and sacrificial giving of His people enabled His work to be funded through this local church.

Over the past five years He has matched our needs almost exactly. We have spent from our Main account in that period £794,045 and collected £788,256, a difference of only 0.8%.

Once again, towards the end of this year we experienced a period when we were spending more than we were bringing in leading to a worrying situation, however the response to this was so encouraging and, as you will see from the attached accounts, although the year ended with a slightly lower closing balance than the previous year, we were still in credit.

This year we have been able to replace the projectors in the main church and are grateful for some very generous specified gifts to cover the cost of this improvement which I am sure you will agree is a very necessary part of our worship experience. We also upgraded the lighting in both the Church and Hall which along with enhancing the ability to control the lighting should also reduce our electricity costs

meaning these improvements should pay for themselves over time.

It is a delight to be able to be able to report that we are now able to support the work of our two youth interns through our missionary account and pray that they will both be blessed and be a blessing through the programme that they are following.

As ever, it is a privilege to be able to serve our LORD as part of the finance team and I would like to thank and pay tribute to the faithful and tireless work carried out by every member of the team. We are blessed by having faithful count teams who week after week selflessly give of their time to count and process our offerings. Thanks also to our Gift Aid Secretary, John Morgan and also to Steve Milburn who uses the gifts he has been given for the Glory of God as he works diligently in the preparation of our accounts.

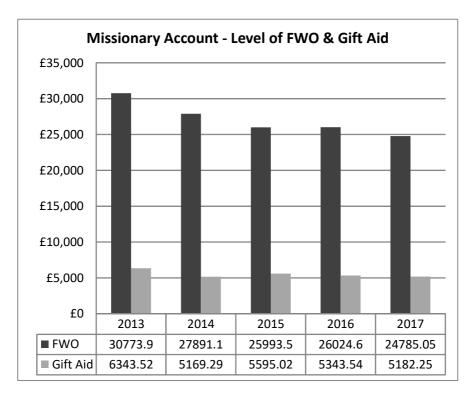
In each of our services we use the phrase "We will continue to worship God with our offering"

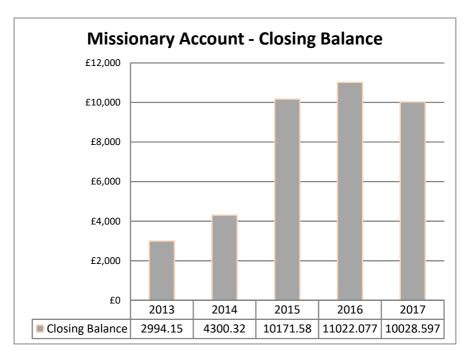
May we continue to worship our Faithful God by returning to him a portion of what he has so richly blessed us with.

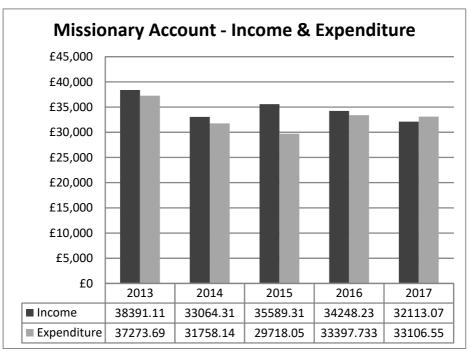
