

NIO ABORTION CONSULTATION

Tuesday 3rd December 7.30 PM in the Link to consider how to respond to the Consultation.

You will need a pen and some paper. Google NIO Consultation Abortion and open the PDF document. There are 15 questions eg Should there be a time limit on abortion? What about fatal foetal abnormality? Who should provide the abortion? Where should they take place? What about abortions after 24 weeks? What about conscientious objections by health professionals? The more individual and small group responses there are the more the Government has to take into consideration such views. The responses cannot be ignored if there is a large of number asking for reasonable consideration of clearly identified issues.

This is the time to make a difference and quite literally save lives.

Be sure the pro-choice lobby ie the proabortion groups, will be working hard to encourage as many as possible to respond making a very bad situation – presently abortion on demand – much worse – abortion up to the end of term.

As those who believe we are created in the image of God it is essential that we take action, making the Government aware of our views on the matter.

To take no action (James 4v17 'whoever knows the right thing to do and fails to do it, for him it is sin') is foolhardy in the extreme. Despite the seeming complexity of the issue we can make a difference. Remember if we accept that the beginning of life has no value then the next logical step will be those who are at the end stages of life.
